AVIATION DAYS Florennes Air Base – Cerfontaine Aerodrome 22 L 23 June 2019

The Royal Belgian Defence Aeroclub (RBDA) has the honor to invite you to participate with your aircraft in the third edition of the Aviation Days on 22nd and 23rd of June 2019. This will give you a special authorization to land and take off from Florennes Air Base during the weekend and to enjoy some time with people passionate about military and civil aviation. The Aircrew Center will be open this year for aircrew and their relatives or friends, where drinks will be served at a reasonable price.

The aim of these Aviation Days is to promote aviation to the general public in close coordination with our hosting authorities of Florennes Air Base. The RBDA will, for the purpose of this event, receive the authorization to allow subscribed civilian aircraft to visit us during these two days. Other special events are planned during the weekend such as the visit of an old cold war ammunition storage bunker. The focus of the activities in the morning of each day will be Florennes Air Base, followed in the afternoon by other activities on the civilian aerodrome of Cerfontaine.

We expect good weather but we never know... What we know for sure is that you will remember those two days as some of the fines days in your aviation experience!

The activities in Florennes are planned on the 22nd and 23rd of June 2019 as follows:

- 1000 Hr: first arrival of visiting aircraft;
- 1000 1200 Hr and 1330 1600 Hr: Fly in and out for civilian aircraft;
- Static display RBDA + F16 + Military Drone, flying activities of military aircraft (Belgian flying demo
 teams only!), and the possibility to visit an old cold war ammunition storage bunker and the Spitfire
 museum;
- Free drink tickets and meals will be offered for two persons on board of the visiting aircraft;

If you are interested to rejoin us you will have to comply to regulations and provide the appropriate documents like airworthiness certificate and review (ARC), insurance certificate and the name of the pilot (attached as annex to this letter, you'll find already the form to be filled-in which has to be sent to Florennes Wing Operation center (Wops) e-mail address: 2wtac-gpv-currentopssqn-woc@mil.be). A couple of days before the event you will receive a PPR with your arrival slot.
